In a one of a kind job connection collaboration, a host committee of community partners including City Commissioner Ed Phillips, State Representative Gwyndolen "Gwyn" Clarke-Reed and the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) has teamed up with Landmark Companies to host a Construction InReach Job Connection on Friday, July 29th from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. at 501 MLK, Jr. Boulevard/Hammondville Road.

The Pompano Beach Construction InReach Job Connection is for all local trades' people, venders, subcontractors and residents looking for work who are interested in participating in the construction of the new \$20 million City Vista project in Pompano Beach. The Job Connection Event will take place on the site of the new project across the street from the E. Pat Larkins Community Center at 501 MLK, Jr. Boulevard.

City Vista is in the NW CRA District and is a 111-Unit Mixed Use Project with ground floor retail, 1-2 bedroom units above with on-Street Parking facing MLK Boulevard, interior covered private breezeway, business center, gym and multi-purpose room.

To accomplish local participation in the construction project, Landmark Companies will break down larger bid packages into smaller scopes and include atypical vendors like food trucks/catering, printing, dumpsters/trash removal, cleaning services and other skilled and unskilled positions to enable greater participation from smaller subcontractors and trades people.
