Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has nine "Mobility" projects planned for Pompano Beach. Mobility projects are bicycle and pedestrian facilities that seek to complement the goals and vision of the Broward MPO's Complete Streets initiative. They are programmed for construction over the next five years, and therefore are referred to as the 2016-2021 Mobility Projects. Below is the list of the nine mobility projects:

1. NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue (Copans Rd to Sample Rd) / Bike lanes
2. Copans Rd (Andrews Ave to NW 1<sup>st</sup> Ave) / Sidewalk along south side of Copans Rd
3. NW 15<sup>th</sup> Street (NW 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave to Dixie Hwy) / Sidewalk along south side of NW 15<sup>th</sup> Street
4. NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street (Flagler Ave to NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave) / Sidewalk along north side of NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street
5. NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street (Flagler Ave to NE 5<sup>th</sup> Ave) / Sidewalk along south side of NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street
6. Dr. MLK Jr Blvd (I-95 to Blount Rd) / Bike lanes
7. Pompano Park Place (Cypress Rd to Powerline Rd) / Bike lanes
8. SW 6<sup>th</sup> Street (Dixie Hwy to Cypress Rd) / Sidewalk along north side of SW 6<sup>th</sup> Street
9. SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street, SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street (Dixie Hwy to Cypress Rd) / Sidewalk access to Pompano Beach elementary school

Broward MPO requires cities to undertake community outreach to establish community support for the projects. The City therefore hosted an Open House on February 12, 2015 at the E Pat Larkin's Center. Residents, elected officials, City staff, Broward MPO representatives and FDOT representatives attended the open house.

Additionally, Broward MPO requires a resolution showing the City's support for the projects. The resolution must be submitted to the MPO by April 2015.

Please prepare a resolution for the City Commission to formally show their support for the above referenced Broward MPO 2016-2021 Mobility Projects.
