MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. BLVD. (HAMMONDVILLE ROAD) AND NW 11TH STREET TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 4TH AVENUE AND GRISHAM AVENUE WITH NW 4TH AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions made by Harry David Grisham, II and Fannie Payton Grisham by adding the name "Grisham Avenue" to a portion of NW 4th Avenue; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 4th Avenue lying between Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. (Hammondville Road) and NW 11th Street shall have the dual designation of NW 4th Avenue and "Grisham Avenue," with NW 4th Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
