SECTION 1. That the Motorcycle Barn is hereby dedicated in memory of Deputy Chris Schaub, Motor 44, Pompano Beach Motor Unit.

SECTION 2. That staff is hereby directed to place signage to reflect the designation.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
