Pompano Beach to Host Hurricane Irma After Action Review Meeting

The City of Pompano Beach will host a public Hurricane Irma after action review meeting on Wednesday, January 10th, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the E. Pat Larkins Community Center. The purpose of the meeting is to solicit feedback from the community regarding Hurricane Irma response and recovery efforts. The meeting will also include a review of initial after-action review findings compiled by Witt O'Brien's, a crisis and emergency management firm.

City Manager Greg Harrison will provide an overview of the City's response and after-action issues. Christina Crue of Witt O'Brien's will review preliminary findings from an assessment of City response activities related to Hurricane Irma. A panel discussion with invited guests from the City of Pompano Beach, Florida Power and Light, Broward County Emergency Management, BSO and FEMA will follow the presentation.

Residents are encouraged to attend and share issues and successes related to the City's response to Hurricane Irma.
