The Seafood Festival is open Friday, April 27th from 5:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.; Saturday, April 28th from 10:00 a.m. - 10:00 p.m.; Sunday, April 29th from 11:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

Tickets are available on line and at the door. There are entrances on the south end at Atlantic and A1A and on the north at A1A and Pier Street.

Friday admission is \$10.00, Saturday is \$20.00 and Sunday daily admission is \$15.00. A three day pass is only \$30.00 (available on line only).
