City Offers Relief to Workers Impacted by Partial Federal Government Shutdown

In an effort to ease the financial impact of the partial federal government shutdown to its residents, the Pompano Beach City Commission has authorized a Utility Billing Program to defer water, waste water, reuse water, storm water and garbage fees for federal employees while the partial federal government shutdown is in effect. In addition, water will not be disconnected during the shutdown for these residents. Individual customers will be provided a 60 day grace-period once the furlough ends in order to bring their deferred balance current.

To qualify, federal employees must live in the City of Pompano Beach Utility Service area and provide identification and a \$0.00 pay stub or letter from their employer stating they are furloughed.
