**ADDENDUM #1, BID H-01-12
FEASIBILITY STUDY PUBLIC SAFETY CAMERAS**

To Whom It May Concern,

Please review the following request for information, and answers provided by the City:

Question: My question is regarding the state, county, city business licenses required to respond and be awarded the RFP. In paragraph 17 on page nine the permits are referenced. Do we need to have an active license at the time of proposal, or can we obtain this upon award.

Answer: The language in this paragraph is general and does not identify any specific requirements for the anticipated contract.

The successful proposer must be authorized to transact business in the State of Florida as required by statute, and this would be required before a contract could be awarded.

If a firm will open an office in the City to service the contract they must comply with the City of Pompano Beach and the Broward County Business Tax Receipts requirements. If the office was not in existence at the time of proposal submission the B.T.R. requirements would not affect the proposal evaluation.

If any of the proposer's staff will perform work that requires a special registration/license (i.e., an Engineer to seal plans), that person must be qualified according to the applicable statutory requirements.

The remainder of the solicitation is unchanged at this time. The deadline for receipt of sealed responses remains 2:00 p.m., November 16, 2011, in the Purchasing office, 1190 N.E. 3rd Avenue, Building C, Pompano Beach, Florida, 33060. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in your submittal.
