To Whom It May Concern,

Please review the questions submitted by potential bidders, and answers from the City.

Question #1: Since this is a small project, will the City of Pompano consider a lower coverage for Commercial General Liability Insurance. The Bid document states that the Contractor must carry not less than \$1,000,000 per claimant and \$2,000,000 per occurrence.

Answer: The City of Pompano will amend the bid requirements for the insurance provisions to reflect the minimum insurance requirement for Commercial General Liability to \$1,000,000 per claimant and \$1,000,000 per occurrence. This will be sufficient based on the scope of services being performed for this project. All other insurance requirements will remain the same.

Question #2: Is there a Grounding Certification?

Answer: Contractors are to bid per plans and specifications.

Question #3: If lead is found, will the City be responsible for removal?

Answer: Contractors are to include the cost for testing of lead paint in their proposals.

Question #4: Will there be a scheduled walk through of the facility?

Answer: Yes, a walkthrough of Fire Station #61 has been scheduled for Monday, April 30th at 2:00 p. m.
