Please review the following questions submitted by potential bidders, and answers from the City.

**Q1:** Is it acceptable to use a Broward County CBE-certified firm in lieu of an SBE-certified firm?

**Response:** For the voluntary 5% participation explained on pages 2 and 3 of the RLI document, the City requests SBE-certified firms.

**Q2:** If not, is it acceptable to use an SBE-certified firm who is certified with Miami-Dade County rather than Broward County?

**Response:** Yes. The third paragraph of section 3 of the RLI states: "Sources of information on certified Small Business Enterprises include the Broward County Small Business Development Division, the State of Florida Office of Supplier Diversity, South Florida Water Management District, and other agencies throughout the State."

**Q3:** On the above-referenced project would you be able to share with me the design requirements for natural daylight?


**Response:** At this point we have not specified the requirements for natural daylight.
