MANAGEMENT OF PARKING OPERATIONS

To Whom It May Concern,

Please review the following questions submitted by short-listed firms, and responses from the City.

Q1: Has the City made a determination as to the type parking equipment? Will there be traditional ticket spitters, gates and a booth with a parking ambassador or should we assume pay and display type controls?

Response: No, the operator should recommend.

Q2: Does the City want us to include this equipment in our proposal?

Response: See #1

Q3: Is the 7,647 of retail shown on the rendering the only site which would feed the valet parking concession or are there any other planned retail / restaurants planned in the immediate area we should consider?

Response: There is substantial redevelopment area nearby.

Q4: #7-How much is the incremental cost to go to 24/7 service, and how many staff does that add? Is this question referring to the enforcement operation, or the garage operation? We were unsure because the RFP already called for 24/7 enforcement coverage.

Response: Garage operation.

Q5: #10-Please submit separate line item pricing for parking enforcement (to write parking citations citywide, 24 hours a day / 7 days a week). Are we correct in our reading of this question, that the City is interested in "expanding" the scope of enforcement beyond what is already in the RFP?

Response: The city currently contracts with an entity to exclusively write citations, technically 24/7. We need proposers to itemize this cost for the city for comparison

purposes, also advising as to number of personnel included in that cost who would be writing citations exclusively and supervisors over that process separately (or proportionate time allocation thereof).

No further technical questions will be received for this solicitation.
