ADDENDUM #1, BID E-30-15

CANAL CLEANING BOAT FOR THE SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT

To Whom It May Concern,

Please review the following questions submitted by potential proposers, and answers from the City.

Q1: We can build them with 26ft hulls however, it will require some engineering time and it will extend our build time significantly. Please let us know if you are set on the 26ft vs. a 23ft unit.

Response: The "required minimum dimensions" of the hull are stated as 26 feet. Please prepare your bid according to section "J" Detailed Specifications. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Q2: We could supply the boat complete with the steering and then you could utilize your local dealer to install the outboards, control package, throttle, and gauges.

Response: Two new Yamaha 25hp (T25LA) outboard engines with (20" shafts, electric start, remote control, power trim and tilt, high trust aluminum prop) will be supplied by the City and installed by bidder. Other necessary hardware; control package; gauges; zinc anodes and tilt and trim assembly will be the responsibility of the bidder and installed in accordance with Marine Industry and Outboard Motor Manufacturers' recommendations.

Q3: It mentions that the Navigation light system be in flexible conduit and can be stored under the console. Our navigation lights are permanent.

Response: Please prepare your bid according to section "J" Detailed Specifications. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Q4: The bid mentions a wheelhouse; a wheelhouse indicates an enclosed area. We recommend a canopy top.

Response: Please prepare your bid according to section "J" Detailed Specifications. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Q5: Concerning the solar battery charger we do not recommend this.

Response: Please prepare your bid according to section "J" Detailed Specifications. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Q6: We can supply a single 40 gallon aluminum fuel tank that is compliant with the current EPA emissions standards. We will mount this right in front of the transom, due to its shape we cannot make this into a padded seat.

Response: Please prepare your bid according to section "J" Detailed Specifications. Failure to do so may result in your bid being deemed non-responsive.

Q7: Are there existing drawings for the boat design or is that something we need to submit with our bid?

Response: There are no existing drawings for the boat design, so please submit drawings, brochures, or other information with your bid.
