ADDENDUM #2, RLI E-31-15

Continuing Contract for Civil Engineering Services for Various City Projects

To Whom It May Concern,

Please review the following questions submitted by potential proposers, and answers from the City.

Q1: Can you tell me what firms currently have this contract?

Response: C3TS (Corzo, Castella, Carballo, Thompson, Salman), and Chen & Associates currently have this contract.

Q2: Does the prime need to be able to provide all the services for the project types listed to submit a proposal?

Response: The prime does not have to provide all the services for the project types. Please list what your firm specializes in.

Q3: To be considered a local business do you have to have your company in the city of pompano or is there another boundary considered local?

Response: Either your company or that of your sub-contractors operating business within the Pompano Beach City limits fulfills our Local Business Enterprise (LBE) goal.

Q4: Is there an application with the City to be certified for this or does the company just need to prove it is within the limits of what is considered local?

Response: A business tax receipt will prove that you or your sub-contractor is a Pompano Beach LBE.

Q5: In regards to the SBE is there an SBE program for the City of Pompano Beach or would a certificate from another state agency such as Palm Beach County or SFWMD qualify a firm for the SBE points?

Response: For its voluntary SBE and LBE program, the City accepts certificates from other agencies, but there are no SBE or LBE "points" associated with this RLI. Per State CCNA guidelines, Certified Minority Business Enterprises (CMBE) are given points.

Please note the following changes to RLI E-31-15:

1. ~~The contracts will be for an initial term of one year, with an option for up to four one-year extensions as agreed to by the Consultant(s) and the City has been replaced by:~~

The initial contract period shall be one year, commencing upon award by the appropriate City officials.

The contract shall be automatically renewed for four (4) additional one-year periods unless the General Services Director or the successful bidder receiving award shall give notice to the other party of intent not to renew for the additional period, which notice must be delivered by certified mail and must be received at least sixty (60) days prior to the end of the initial contract period. All terms, prices and conditions shall remain firm for the initial period of the contract, and any renewal period.


The preceding change shall apply both to the extension clause on page 1, and the repetition on page 2, item 3 of the RLI.
