
Pompano Beach Intersections: Vinyl Wrap Traffic Signal Control Boxes



MINIMUM CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO PERMIT REQUESTS

1. Owner or Utility agrees to maintain permitted facility, including the restoration of the surrounding right-of-way, at his/her sole expense and, if required by Broward County to promptly modify, relocate and/or remove said facility as required, at the owner's or utility's own sole expense. All portions of the public right-of-way disturbed or impaired during the maintenance, modification, relocation or removal of the permitted facility shall also be restored by owner or utility at owner's or utility's own expense and Broward County will have no responsibility therefore. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-6.8)
2. All materials, installations and methods of work in County rights-of-way must be in accordance with the "Minimum Standards Applicable to Rights-of-Way under Broward County Jurisdiction", and Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division Requirements. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-1.10)
3. All work in public right-of-way shall be done in strict compliance with the rules and regulations of the Traffic Control Manuals, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Broward County Public Works and Transportation Department. Failure to comply shall result in cessation of operations and the removal of project-related obstructions from public right-of-way until compliance is achieved. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-1.1)
4. Prior to commencement of construction within Broward County jurisdiction rights of way, the permittee shall contact the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division (954) 577-4600 to schedule a preconstruction meeting. Failure to comply may result in a revocation of this permit. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-3.1)
5. No construction shall be initiated until a permit for the proposed installation has been issued by the Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-2.2)
6. The contractor must submit maintenance of traffic plan to the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division (954) 847-2600 and obtain approval prior to commencing work in the right of way. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-1.3 & 4-1.4)
7. A minimum of forty-eight (48) hour notice must be given to the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division before commencing work on any project. - Telephone Number (954) 577-4600. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-3.2)
8. A minimum of twenty-four (24) hour notice must be given to Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division for scheduling of all tests and inspections relating to this permit. Scheduling is done on a "First Come, First Served" basis. - Telephone Number (954) 577-4600. The Engineer of Record for the project shall be present for all inspections and tests, unless instructed otherwise by the Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-3.3)
9. A set of plans for the project bearing the Highway Construction and Engineering Division approval stamp, the Permit issued by the Highway Construction and Engineering Division, and the MOT plan approved by the Traffic Engineering Division, shall all be onsite whenever work is in progress. In the event that any one of these items is not so located, work shall not be allowed to begin or, if already begun, shall be halted. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-6.1)
10. Permitted work shall not be deemed approvable until all installations, tests and restorations are complete and approved by the Consulting Engineer, all other agencies having jurisdiction, and this Division; and all required Test Reports, Certifications and "Record" drawings have been submitted to and accepted by all agencies requiring as-built approval. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-8 & 3-9)
11. "Record" drawings and certification package, as required by the "Minimum Standards Applicable to Rights-of-Way under Broward County Jurisdiction", must be submitted to the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division prior to final inspection. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-8)
Paving and Drainage (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 6-1.13 & 6-1.18)
 - a. One (1) set of certified drainage as-built drawings signed and sealed by a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Florida together with the Engineer's Certification. All drainage installations shall be tested for leakage prior to backfilling; and
 - b. One (1) set of finished rock base as-built drawings signed and sealed by a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Florida and certified by a Professional Engineer registered in the State of Florida, stating that the installation shown thereon was made in substantial conformance with the approved drawings. Finished rock as-built drawings shall be at the same scale as the approved drawings and must show finished rock base elevations and offsets at centerline, edge of median and edge of pavement, plus elevations of bottom of swale or flow line of gutter, top of curb and right of way line, at high point and low points, intersections and changes in slope. Elevations shall be verified and shown at intervals not to exceed 300 feet measured along the profile grade line for projects over 1500 feet in length; every 100 feet for projects 500 to 1500 feet in length and every 50 feet for projects under 500 feet in length. These elevations shall be depicted on a set of plans at the same scale, with sufficient clarity to make judgment of acceptability possible; and
 - c. All test reports including One (1) copy of the density reports on the compaction of the subgrade, base, shoulders and swales verified by an independent certified Engineering Testing Laboratory.Water and Sewer (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 10-6, 11-5 & 12-6)

One (1) set of certified as-built drawings signed and sealed by a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Florida together with the Engineer's Certification. All drawings shall indicate accurate house connection dimensions, main and terminal point locations, elevations of stubs or laterals, locations and elevations of all changes in direction and slope, rim elevations, invert elevations and structure numbers. In addition the size, material, location and elevation of all underground utilities encountered during construction shall be indicated on the plan; and

Gas Transmission and Distribution Systems, Telephone, CATV, Other Signal Systems or Electric Power
(2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 13-3, 14-10, 15-9 and 16-9)

Record drawings may be required on a case by case basis. When required one (1) set of record drawings shall be submitted within three (3) weeks after completion of the work along with a statement signed by the Engineering Supervisor of the utility company certifying as to the accuracy of the as-built locations and elevations of the permitted installations and further certifying that the permitted installation was done in substantial accordance with the approved drawings.

Landscape Irrigation (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 19-6)

One (1) set of certified as-built drawings signed and sealed by a Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Florida together with the Engineer's or Landscape Architects Certification. All drawings shall indicate location and elevation information.

Monitoring Well (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 20-7)

On completion of construction, the contractor must furnish the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division with a "Well Completion Report".
12. A Notice of Acceptance shall be sent to permittee, and the one year warranty maintenance period will commence during which the permittee shall, at his/her sole expense, repair or cause to be repaired, any defects that may be identified within the public right-of-way due to or arising from the permitted installation(s) or the permittee's operations related to the project. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 6-1.19 & 7-2.15)
13. This permit shall expire under the following circumstances; unless other arrangements have been made with the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division. Once a permit has expired, before any work may continue, begin or resume, a new permit shall be obtained with all current conditions and regulations having to be met including new plan approval. A new permit fee shall be charged for the uncompleted portion only.
 - A. If construction of permitted work is not commenced within 180 calendar days. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-2.1); or,
 - B. If permitted work, once begun, is suspended for more than 90 days. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-2.2); or,
 - C. Upon completion of the permitted work (including restoration), and acceptance by the permittee, all regulatory agencies involved, and the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-2.3); or
 - D. Evidence of incorrect, misleading or omitted information having significant bearing on the approvability of a previously approved plan shall be cause for rescission of the Highway Construction and Engineering Division permit and suspension of work (if started), and resubmittal of the corrected plans for approval. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-1.9); or
 - E. Upon the passage of two (2) years from the date of issuance. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 4-2.4)
14. Permittee is solely responsible for any relocation(s) of new or existing facilities required as a result of this permitted construction. Permittee is responsible for notification/coordination with owners of previously permitted facilities located within County Jurisdiction rights of way.
15. Permittee hereby indemnifies and holds Broward County harmless for any loss arising from permittee's installation or operations under this permit.
16. This permit only applies to authorization from the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division. It is possible that additional permits may be necessary. Nothing contained herein relieves the permittee from timely complying with applicable laws of other Federal, State or Local Governments.
17. It is expressly understood that this permit is for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or vest any property right in said holder.
18. Prior to construction of any improvements within the county jurisdiction right of way, the permittee shall notify the Sunshine State One-Call of Florida, Inc. for underground facility locations, as set forth in the "Underground Facility Damage Prevention and Safety Act" of the State of Florida, Chapter 556 Florida Statutes. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-1.6)
19. Excavated materials shall not be stockpiled in the public right of way during construction without specific approval of the Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division. All excess materials shall be removed from the worksite and disposed of legally by the permittee at his own expense. (2005 Broward County Minimum Standards 3-6.6.2)
20. The owner understands and agrees that portions of driveways within the public right of way that are disturbed and/or removed for permitted work will be replaced only with asphalt or plain concrete having no additives, coloring, special finishes or patterns.
21. In the event it becomes necessary, for any reason, to continue work operations beyond the normal hours of operation for the Division, the Contractor whose name appears on the face of this Permit acknowledges their commitment to pay the associated Broward County Highway Construction & Engineering Division and Traffic Engineering Division charged overtime expenses, prior to requesting a final inspection on the project. (Broward County Resolution 1999-1140)

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT APPROVAL

DECORATIVE ART-WRAP INSTALLATIONS ON BROWARD COUNTY OWNED TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROLLER CABINETS

1. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF PERMIT. The special conditions herein are supplemental requirement to the applicable minimum standard conditions contained within the Broward County Public Works Department, Highway Construction & Engineering Division APPLICATION FOR PERMIT FOR CONSTRUCTION IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY. The special conditions described are intended to meet the special circumstances associated with the installation and maintenance of decorative art-wrap coverings on specified traffic signal controller cabinets.
2. APPLICATION OF ART-WRAPPS. The art-wraps coverings shall be attached to the County's traffic signal controller cabinets only. The installation of the art-wrap coverings are limited to the external flat surfaces of the signal controller cabinet only, and shall not be attached to any other signal equipment, such as conduits, signal poles or pedestrian assemblies. The controller cabinet locations that the PERMITTEE will be attaching the art-wraps shall be clearly denoted both in tabular format and on a local area map to be submitted as **Exhibit "A"** attached to the Permit application.
3. ARTWRAP DESIGN CONTENT. PERMITTEE shall provide attached as part of the Permit an **Exhibit "B"** consisting of colored scale renderings of the proposed art-wrap design(s), indicating which designs shall be applied to which sides of the signal controller cabinet, and which designs shall be installed at which locations identified in **Exhibit "A"**. Designs are intended to be artistic in nature, representing a natural, cultural, artistic or historic theme or event associated with the municipality or community. Acceptability of any designs shall be in accordance with applicable COUNTY policies as outlined in the Broward County Advantage Marketing Program.

Designs that promote or encourage the use of the following shall be **prohibited**:

Tobacco: Designs associated with or which may be associated with cigars, cigarettes, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, and other tobacco products.

Alcohol: Designs associated with or which may be associated with alcoholic beverages including, but not limited to, beer, wine, and distilled spirits. When a special event permit has been obtained that permits the sale of beer, wine or liquor, signage to identify the vendor(s) location(s) and product(s) is permitted.

Human Reproduction/Sexuality Products and Services: Designs associated with or which may be associated with products or services related to human reproduction, sexuality, or sexual stimulation, including but not limited to contraceptive products or services, other products or services related to

sexual hygiene and counseling with regard to pregnancy, abortion, or other sexual matters or entertainment directed to sexual stimulation.

Demeaning or disparaging words: Designs containing words that demean or disparage an individual or group of individuals on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, gender, gender identity or expression, pregnancy, age, disability, ethnicity, or sexual orientation.

Profanity: Designs containing profane language.

Firearms: Designs containing an image or depiction of a firearm.

Violence: Designs containing an image or description of graphic violence or the depiction of weapons or other implements or devices associated with an act(s) of violence or harm to a person or animal.

Unlawful goods or services: Designs which promote or encourage, or appear to promote or encourage, unlawful or illegal goods or services.

Unlawful conduct: Designs which promote or encourage, or appear to promote or encourage, unlawful or illegal behavior or activities.

Obscenity or Nudity: Designs which contain obscene material or imply or appear to imply, or promote or appear to promote nudity. For purposes of these guidelines, the terms "obscene" and "nudity" shall have the meanings contained in Florida Statutes, as may be amended from time to time.

Endorsement: Designs which imply or declare an endorsement by a County agency or the Board without the prior written authorization of the Board.

"Adult"-oriented goods or services: Designs which promote or encourage, or appear to promote or encourage, adult book stores, nude dance clubs, and other adult entertainment establishments, adult telephone services, adult Internet sites, and escort services.

Potential Danger: Designs which contain the word "stop," "drive," "danger" or any other word, phrase, symbol, lighting, or any devices or any components thereof, or character likely to interfere with or mislead pedestrian or vehicular traffic.

The ultimate acceptability of any proposed design resides solely with the COUNTY.

4. TERM OF PERMIT. The PERMITTEE shall be permitted to apply art-wrap coverings to the County's traffic signal controller for a period of five (5) years beyond the initial permit approval of the art-wrap coverings, or until such time as the COUNTY revokes

the permit, whichever occurs first. This does not preclude the PERMITTEE for re-applying for a new Permit to extend the term of the art-wrap covering.

5. USE OF CONTROLLER CABINETS. PERMITTEE shall have access and non-exclusive use of the County's signal controller cabinets only for PERMITTEE's art-wrap Program. The controller cabinets shall not be used for any other purpose.
6. NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO ART-WRAP INSTALLATION. PERMITTEE shall provide three (3) business-day notice to the Traffic Engineering Division prior to the installation of any art-wrap at a location set forth in **Exhibit "A."**
7. CONTROLLER CABINET IDENTIFICATION LABELS. COUNTY shall fabricate and install a new controller cabinet identification sticker to be placed on an agreed upon location on each of the controller cabinets after application of the art-wrap covering. New identification labels will be fabricated with retro-reflective white background with black text unless otherwise specified.
8. CONTROLLER CABINET REMOVAL OR MODIFICATION BY COUNTY. COUNTY shall provide five (5) days notification to the PERMITTEE prior to any scheduled modification or removal of the controller cabinet or related equipment that would require the removal of any art-wrap coverings. The PERMITTEE will have the option to reinstall the art-wrap covering at its own expense after re-installation of the controller cabinet by COUNTY.
9. DAMAGE TO CONTROLLER CABINET BY THIRD PARTIES. COUNTY will notify PERMITTEE as soon as practical following an event (such as a traffic crash) that results in damage to the controller cabinet that also damages the art-wrap covering, or otherwise requires replacement of the controller cabinet. The PERMITTEE will have the option to reinstall the art-wrap covering at its own expense after repair or replacement of the controller cabinet by COUNTY. Replacement of the controller cabinet required due to a vehicle crash or other similar event that was not caused by the actions of the PERMITTEE shall be replaced by the COUNTY at the COUNTY's expense.
9. DAMAGE TO ART-WRAP BY THIRD PARTIES. The PERMITTEE shall repair or replace the art-wrap at its own expense due to accidental or intentional damage by third parties, such as by vandalism or graffiti. In the event the art-wrap incurs multiple or repeated damage or defacing by graffiti, the PERMITTEE shall have the option to remove the art-wrap from the controller cabinet permanently at its own cost.
10. TERMINATION. This Permit may be terminated immediately by COUNTY if any terms of the permit are not adhered to by the PERMITTEE during the term of the permit. The Permit may otherwise be terminated by COUNTY without cause, or for convenience, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the PERMITTEE by COUNTY.
