PARADE CATEGORIES

◆ Floats

- * Floats may not solely depict the products or services of a float sponsor.
- * Floats must be capable of negotiated sharp turns. Maximum float height is 13.5 feet; maximum width is 9 feet.
- * Floats must have a good running motor, with adequate fuel.
- * Float application must include a photo, sketch or rendering of the float, preferably in color.
- * Floats must be fire code compliant. Fire extinguishers are required on each float.
- * All drivers must have a valid driver's license, be insured and each vehicle must have adequate fuel.

◆ Performing/Walking Groups

- * Band members, directors, and support personnel must be in uniform.
- * Marching groups must move forward at all times.
- * Performers must perform throughout the entire parade route with a 30 second spot at the judges' stand.
- * Groups should ensure they have enough water to provide for all members in your group.
- * Performing/Walking groups should be able to walk at least 1.5 miles.

◆ Animals

- * Entries with animals must provide their own pooper scooper and wheel barrels to follow their unit down the parade route.
- * Animals must be able to travel in extreme hot weather.
- * Animals must be secured and controlled at all times.

◆ Vehicles

- * All vehicle types are welcome.
- * Applications must include a photo of the vehicle.
- * Vehicles must be clean and in good working condition.
- * All drivers must have a valid driver's license, be insured and each vehicle must have adequate fuel.

PARADE RULES

- ◆ Applications are due by 5:00pm on Friday, November 3, 2017 to the Emma Lou Olson Civic Center (1801 NE 6 Street, Pompano Beach, FL 33060)
- ◆ Adult spotters are required for all entries.
- ◆ Entries must be designed to be viewed from both sides and float number must be visible at all times.
- ◆ Floats, vehicles, walking groups **MUST** be decorated in the holiday theme/colors or they will not be allowed to participate. All entries are required to be decorated in keeping with the season of the parade. Vehicles that are not fully decorated and add nothing to the enjoyment of the parade will be pulled from the line up.
- ◆ While we love our local business, your entry **MUST** be festive and in line with the Yuletide Holiday.
- ◆ Due to safety regulations throwing candy or pamphlets is prohibited. No printed material may be handed out along the parade route.
- ◆ Stopping along the parade route is prohibited. Judges will be located throughout the parade route.
- ◆ Santa will be arriving on the last float. Please do not dress as Santa ... it confuses the children!
- ◆ Parade will be held rain or shine.
