**PLUMBER**

**GENERAL**

Skilled work as a journeyman plumber and performs related maintenance work on City buildings and property. Work is performed under general supervision.

**EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Estimates materials needed for various projects and has such materials on hand.

Installs and repairs various plumbing fixtures and installations as required.

Records time and materials used on various projects.

Performs other general building maintenance work not necessarily related to plumbing.

Performs related work as required.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

Knowledge of the practices and procedures involved in a plumbing operation. Knowledge of the tools, supplies and materials used in plumbing, and in their applications. Knowledge of the plumbing trade.

Ability to work neatly and efficiently with a minimum of direct supervision. Ability to perform building maintenance and repair work.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Graduation from high school or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Considerable experience in plumbing and general building maintenance work.

A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS**

Must have the use of sensory skills in order to effectively communicate and interact with other employees and the public through the use of the telephone and personal contact as normally defined by the ability to see, read, talk, hear, handle or feel objects and controls. Physical capability to effectively use and operate various items of office related equipment, such as, but not limited to a, personal computer, calculator, copier, and fax machine. Significant standing, walking, moving, climbing, carrying,

bending, kneeling, crawling, reaching, and handling, sitting, standing, pushing, and pulling. Ability to lift heavy objects.

### **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

Possession of a valid, appropriate (Class B) driver's license and an acceptable driving record.
