**TV EQUIPMENT OPERATOR**

**GENERAL**

Technical and supervisory work in the operation of closed circuit television equipment. Work is performed under general supervision.

**EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

(These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Operates a closed circuit television camera, T.V. monitors, generators, air compressors, packers and a truck.

Evaluates results of a sewer line inspection by T.V. as to condition of a line, what is wrong with line, type of leak and type of repair required to repair the sewer line.

Prepares and mixes the proper chemicals to pressure repair a sewer line with chemicals. Repairs the line and records all results on a video recorder. Presents test results to engineers and contractors.

Enforces positive safety procedures.

Marks blueprints as to sewer line problems and provides accurate statistical data as required.

Performs related work as required.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

Knowledge of the practices and procedures of sewer repair. Knowledge of math and elementary chemistry. Knowledge of all tools and equipment related to sewer work.

Ability to work outdoors under adverse conditions, night or day.

Skill in the use of T.V. equipment.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Graduation from high school or possession of an acceptable equivalency diploma. Must attain a certificate for the operation and evaluation of closed circuit T.V. Considerable experience in sewer maintenance work.

A comparable amount of training and experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

## **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS**

Must have the use of sensory skills in order to effectively communicate and interact with other employees and the public through the use of the telephone and personal contact as normally defined by the ability to see, read, talk, hear, handle or feel objects and controls. Physical abilities include walking, kneeling, bending, stooping, pushing and pulling. Must be able to perform moderate lifting up to 50 lbs.

Work is often performed in confined spaces. Exposure to chemicals, machinery hazards and adverse weather conditions.

## **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

Possession of a valid, appropriate (Class C) driver's license and an acceptable driving record.
