NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the City Commission Meeting on June 23, 2015 at 6:00 p.m., the City Commission approved the FY 2015-2016 Proposed Annual Action Plan funding below. The draft 2015-2020 Consolidated Plan is available for review on the City's web site, www.pompanobeachfl.gov, or in person at the Office of Housing and Urban Improvement. The City of Pompano Beach is a HUD entitlement community. As such, we receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME grant funding that we allocate to local non-profit organizations and City departments that administer public service, housing, public facilities, economic development and infrastructure for our residents. This year, the City's allocation is **\$908,600.00** for CDBG and **\$284,923.00** for HOME, totaling **\$1,193,523**.
