

Flag Program for Handicapped Patrons

At the Pompano Beach golf courses, we recognize the needs of the disabled golfer and make every effort to accommodate these needs and promote the most enjoyable playing environment.

If you have a permanent walking impairment or another condition that makes it difficult to enjoy the golf course, we have a Flag Program in place that will hopefully assist you.

By providing proof of a disability such as a government-issued permanent disabled car placard or sticker (or other identifying information), we will provide you with a flag that can be attached to the golf car. Flags are available in the Golf Shop. The flag allows you to:

- Drive the golf car up to the fringe of the putting green
- Drive the golf car up to the edge of the teeing ground

In order to maintain proper golf course conditions, the golf car cannot be driven directly onto the putting green or teeing ground. While operating the golf car under these guidelines, we ask that consideration be given to current golf course conditions and that every effort is made to avoid wet conditions, unsafe areas (slopes), and potential situations that could cause damage to the golf course. On days when golf car usage is restricted to "golf car path only", flags will not be available. A "golf car path only" restriction would be in force in consideration for extreme weather conditions or specific golf maintenance practices. If you require the use of a flag, we ask that you contact the Golf Shop (Phone: 954-781-0426) in advance of play to make sure golf course conditions allow the use of a flag for the day.

If you need additional accommodations due to a permanent disability that doesn't allow you to leave a golf car, we have a SoloRider accessible golf car available at the golf facility. If you need to use this golf car, we ask that you contact the Golf Shop 24 hours in advance so we can make sure this golf car is ready for your use on the golf course. The stated golf car fee will be charged for the use of the SoloRider accessible golf car.
