Blue Skies Ahead

The vision for Hillsboro Inlet District includes:

- ❖ Redeveloped as a modern fishing village that promotes water-dependent uses, mixed-use developments and hotels
- ❖ New development fronting ICW to dedicate continuous public walkway along the ICW edge
- ❖ Pedestrian connectivity across SR A1A
- ❖ Redeveloped commercial sites with parking in rear, inviting entrances from SR A1A sidewalks and outdoor dining fronting Hillsboro Inlet Park
- ❖ Parking provided in garages and placed away from SR A1A
- ❖ Improved bicycle access and facilities including ample bicycle parking and designs that enhance fishing village theme
- ❖ Water taxi stop that provides accessibility to destinations along the ICW throughout the county
- ❖ Retail uses that support marine visitors, including supplies for boaters and divers
- ❖ Improved streetscape that increases pedestrian nighttime safety and walkability, including pedestrian scale lighting and wide sidewalks separated from roadway
- ❖ Landmarks and wayfinding features to increase visibility of Hillsboro Inlet Park and entrance to city
- ❖ Architecture style that resembles a modern fishing village, with sloped roofs, verandas, blurring of indoor and outdoor spaces, light colors with bold accents, lots of windows, and upper flood porches


