



2019 City of Pompano Beach Solid Waste and Recycling Scholars Program

The City of Pompano Beach in partnership with Waste Management, Inc. provides an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors who have shown an interest in environmental issues and have made a commitment to continuing their education by attending a college, university, or technical/trade school.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a Florida resident and a U. S. citizen or eligible non-citizen, as determined by the student's post-secondary institution.
- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Pompano Beach high school.
- Applicant must have already been accepted into an accredited college/university or a vocational/technical program.
- Proof of enrollment is required at the time of scholarship award.
- Applicant must complete all sections of the application and submit it via email for consideration.
- Applicant will need to submit two letters of recommendation from non-relatives, one of which must be from a faculty member from the high school currently attending.
- Applicant must provide a transcript from the high school currently attending.

Deadline

Applications must be received via email to **Recycling@copbfl.com** no later than March 31, 2019 at 11:59 p.m.

Awards

A one-time scholarship of \$2,500 will be awarded to each of the top four (4) applicants. Award criteria are based upon academics, participation in school related activities, community service, participation in environmental clean-up or preservation activities, and the personal essay. Character references, application verification, and evidence of enrollment in post-secondary education must be provided prior to the scholarship being awarded.
