**CHANGES IN SERVICE BEGINNING FEBRUARY 29, 2016**

**1 NEW! Garbage Carts** - garbage will be collected two times per week

Pompano Beach residents will receive a new garbage cart. Your new cart will replace your old cans or containers. Roll your cart to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day and remove it the day of collection. Cart handles must face away from the street with lid opening facing the street. Refer to the cart guidelines on the back page for more information.

**ALL** garbage, including vegetative materials and yard trash such as palm fronds, coconuts and grass clippings must be placed inside the cart with lids closed. *Only vegetative material and yard trash that is too large to fit in your cart should be set out for bulk removal.*

Please bag all garbage to keep carts clean & odor-free.

- Only City-provided carts will be collected.
- Resident-owned cans or containers **WILL NOT** be serviced.
- Any materials left outside of the cart or on top of the cart **WILL NOT** be collected.



**2 NEW! Recycling Carts** - recycling will be collected one time per week

Residents will receive a new recycling cart. Now you can recycle even more materials in one cart.

Roll your cart to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day and remove it the day of collection. Cart handles must face away from the street with the lid opening facing the street. Refer to the cart guidelines on the back page for more information.

**ALL** recycling must be placed in your new cart with lids closed for collection. Acceptable recycling materials include: aluminum and tin cans; glass bottles and jars; plastic containers with the number 1, 2 or 3 on the bottom; magazines; phonebooks and newspapers.

- Any material left outside of or on top of the cart **will not** be collected.
- Please reuse or recycle your old blue recycling bin.




**3 NEW! Updated Collection Map & Schedule** - Refer to the map and chart below to determine your collection days.

**Beginning February 29, 2016, your service days may have changed.** Please refer to the collection map and collection schedule below.

Garbage and vegetative waste and yard waste will be collected twice per week in the new garbage cart. Recycling will be collected one time per week in the new recycling cart. Bulk will be collected one time per week.

To determine your collection days:

- (1) Locate your address on the map to the left.
- (2) Identify the color for your area.
- (3) Match the color from the map with the corresponding color on the Collection Schedule Chart shown below.

**4 NEW! Bulk Waste Collection Schedule & Drop-Off Location** - Bulk will now be collected ONE time per week. Extra bulk waste can be dropped off on Saturdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the new Pompano Beach drop-off location. See information below.



**Bulk Waste Collection Guidelines:**

Only materials generated from the location will be removed. It is unlawful to bring materials from another location and place out for removal.

Materials do not include household hazardous waste, special wastes, construction and demolition waste, vehicle parts, tires, electronics, or products containing glass which may break during collection.

Bulk waste items must be in such a size and/or quantity that does not allow for the materials to be placed into the garbage cart for normal garbage service.

Materials for removal should be placed off the roadway, on the front swale.

Place items away from power lines, fire hydrants, trees, fences or any other item that would impede collection of the material.

Do not place materials out for removal earlier than 5:00 p.m. prior to your collection day.

\*A cubic yard is approximately equivalent to the size of a household refrigerator.

Residents must properly prepare horticulture by bundling and placing at the curb. Branches and limbs should not exceed six (6) feet in length and five (5) inches in diameter. Stumps should not exceed 50 pounds each.

Residents are limited to four cubic yards of material each week.\*

Extra bulk waste can be dropped off on Saturdays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at our new drop-off location: 1951 N. Powerline Road, Pompano Beach. Proof of residency required.

**Acceptable Bulk Items**

Household Goods - Appliances, furniture, mattresses, large toys, draperies and other miscellaneous materials that are normally found in a residential household.

Horticulture - Trimmings from bushes, shrubs and trees which do not exceed six feet in length. Materials must be in such a size and/or quantity that does not allow for the materials to be containerized for normal garbage service.

Building Materials - Wooden fence sections six feet or less in height and length, wooden doors, sinks, toilets, wood scraps, and other materials generated from MINOR building repair, not to exceed 1/2 cubic yard.\*

Miscellaneous - Cardboard boxes; empty cartons and other materials that are too large to be containerized for normal garbage service.

**Guidelines for using your new carts**

- Set carts out by 7:00 a.m. on collection day.
- Remove carts from the curb on the day of collection.
- Place vegetative materials (yard trash) into the garbage (grey) cart.
- Set carts at least three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward street.
- Allow at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, etc.
- All materials must be placed inside the carts. **Any material outside of the cart or on top of the cart will not be collected.** Note: Extra materials will be accepted during the week of Christmas, December 25th through January 1st.
- Lids must be closed.
- Garbage should be bagged to help keep carts clean and odor-free.
- Full carts cannot weigh over 150 pounds.

**Try your new garbage cart for 90 days**

If you are not happy with the size of your new garbage cart, call Waste Management for a one-time swap to a different size cart. Orders for swapping your cart will be open from June 1st through June 30th. Call Waste Management: (954) 974-7500.

**Holiday Schedule**

Christmas Day is the only time waste services are suspended. If your service day falls on Christmas, it will be collected on the next regularly scheduled collection day. If you are an absentee owner, please pass this information to your tenants.

**Streetlights**

To report a streetlight that is out, please call (954) 786-4108. If possible, get the 11-digit number from the pole. If you are unable to find the number, have the address available.

**Illegal Dumping is a Crime!**

Illegal dumping is a crime. In fact, it is a FELONY. Please report anyone illegally dumping by calling 911. Materials that are placed out for disposal must be generated from the property. It is illegal to bring materials from another location, even if you own both locations. Individuals that are caught illegally dumping will be arrested and their vehicles impounded.

**Hurricane Preparedness**

Prior to the storm, safely secure your garbage and recycling carts inside your garage or residence. After the storm, separate vegetative waste (trees and shrubs) from other bulky items and garbage. Normal garbage service will resume after the storm as soon as roads are accessible.

**Hazardous Materials (HHW)**

Items such as rechargeable batteries, house paints, computers, TVs, tires and other hazardous household wastes (HHW) cannot be collected at curbside. The City of Pompano Beach has joined with other surrounding cities to provide hazardous materials collection events. These events are held during the year at various locations and there is no cost to Pompano Beach residents. Proof of residency is required.
