City of Pompano Beach Unveils Historical Timeline

The City of Pompano Beach and the Historic Preservation Board are unveiling the Historical Timeline of Pompano Beach to be displayed in the City Hall lobby located at 100 W. Atlantic Boulevard. This beautiful display will illuminate the achievements of our local trail blazers in a chronological context. The informative and interactive exhibit will be revealed during a free event held in the City Hall lobby, Thursday, February 27th, at 10:00 a.m.

The Development Services Department received a grant from the Florida Humanities to create this display. It is a free-standing exhibit standing five feet by eight feet that artistically depicts Pompano Beach's history through text and graphics. There is also a small touch-screen, interactive laptop for patrons to further explore topics on the display they find interesting. This project is part of the Historic Preservation Board's continuing effort to promote and maintain the City's history, and in turn enrich our everyday lives through connecting us with our heritage.
