City Announces Public Beach Closure to Further Contain Coronavirus

To protect public health and contain the transmission of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the City of Pompano Beach is closing its public beach effective Wednesday, March 18th, at 6:00 a.m.

In a meeting held this afternoon with the mayors and city managers of Pompano Beach and Deerfield Beach and the town manager of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea, these cities have all agreed to close their public beaches effective Wednesday, March 18th, at 6:00 a.m.

In accordance with Florida Governor Ron Desantis' new orders, the City also mandates bars and nightclubs to close at 5:00 p.m. and restaurants to practice distance separation by not allowing groups larger than 10 people to gather. Take-out and delivery are strongly encouraged.

The City continues to monitor and collaborate with local, state and federal agencies regarding the Coronavirus and will evaluate future actions necessary to protect the health and well-being of our residents and visitors.
