City Issues Executive Order to Close Restaurants

To protect public health and contain the transmission of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the City of Pompano Beach has issued an Executive Order to close restaurants.

In a Proclamation issued this afternoon, Mayor Rex Hardin declared and re-established that a public health emergency exists and issued an Executive Order requiring all restaurants, cafeterias, and other food establishments within the City of Pompano Beach to close effective 10:00 p.m., Friday, March 20th for 30 days up through and including April 17th.

Such establishments may provide drive-thru, delivery, take-out, and exterior pick-up food services only.

In affirming a commitment to our local community Mayor Hardin stated, "I encourage all of our residents to visit our local restaurants which remain open and order food for take-out and delivery".
