City Announces Small Business Relief Grant Program

The City of Pompano Beach is launching a new grant program to offer relief to small business owners during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Small Business Relief Grant Program, an initiative of the Economic Response Team, will provide a one-time grant of up to \$25,000 to help bridge the gap for small businesses enduring hardship during this difficult time. The City's Office of Housing and Urban Improvement is sponsoring this program by utilizing funds from the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG).

Businesses must have 25 employees or less to qualify. Completed applications will be reviewed on a first ready first serve basis. City Hall remains closed to the public at this time, so applications will only be accepted through email.
