COVID-19 Vaccines to Begin at Citi Centre
1955 North Federal Highway
Wednesday, March 17th

The Florida Department of Health in Broward County (DOH-Broward) will begin COVID-19 vaccinations by appointment only at Citi Centre in Pompano Beach beginning Wednesday, March 17, 2021. Citi Centre is located at 1955 N Federal Highway at the corner of Copans Road and Federal Highway.

In accordance with [Executive Order 21-62](#), the current prioritized groups below are eligible to receive a vaccine at this site:

- Persons 60 years of age and older;
- K-12 school employees 50 years of age and older;
- Sworn law enforcement officers 50 years of age and older;
- Firefighters 50 years of age and older; and
- Health care personnel with direct patient contact.

Additionally, all persons determined by a physician to be extremely vulnerable to COVID-19 may receive a vaccine with a signed physician attestation.

The City of Pompano Beach is partnering with DOH-Broward, Broward County and Broward Sheriff's Office by assisting with site staffing and resources. Vaccines will be available by appointment only. The site will be open Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays. It will be closed Thursdays and Sundays. Hours of operation will be from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

DOH-Broward is utilizing the statewide appointment system. Individuals can pre-register for the vaccine by calling: 866-201-6313 or 844-252-2003 for TTY users, or by visiting myvaccine.fl.gov. All eligible individuals will be contacted when an appointment is available for them.

"I am thrilled to announce the Florida Department of Health in Broward County will be administering COVID vaccinations to residents at our Citi Centre site", said Pompano Beach Mayor Rex Hardin. "I'm especially happy to see shots given in the northeast part of Broward County which will make it easier for area residents".

The owner of the property, Sterling Organization, has given the City permission to use the location as a food distribution site, which will continue every other Thursday, and now as a vaccination site on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays.
