

GUIDELINE FOR LOBBYIST

- All lobbyists, that is, a person who is retained, with or without compensation, for the purpose of lobbying, or a person who is employed by another person or entity, on a full-time or part-time basis, principally to lobby on behalf of that other person or entity, must complete a Lobbyist Registration Form and file it with the City Clerk's Office prior to engaging in any lobbying activities in the City. You can obtain the Lobbyist Registration Form on the City's website via the City Commission – Ethics Page or you can visit the City Clerk's Office to receive a copy of the form. Should you have any questions regarding the registration process, please contact the City Clerk's Office at (954) 786-4611.
- As per the requirements of the Broward County's Ethics Ordinance as amended, effective as of April 1, 2016 all lobbyists are required to submit a contact log within three days after meeting with a member of the City Commission. This contact log is accessible on the City's website via the City Commission – Ethics Page. Should you have any questions, please contact the City Clerk's Office at (954) 786-4611.
