5. Permitting for Construction

This project consists of improvements to Terra Mar Drive Bridge, built in 1981, based on FDOT's Bridge Management System report. Project includes replacement recommendations for the deck, repairs to the superstructure, and substructure, safety railings, utilities upgrade and aesthetics enhancement.

## PROJECT UPDATES

The (Pre-Design) Public Outreach process was completed. The community voiced concern with maintenance of traffic to the island, potential impacts to utilities services, ADA sidewalk, and aesthetic finish of the bridge. Consultant also completed environmental survey at site and discussions with BC Engineering Department. An initial coordination/review meeting with the project team and key City departments was held in September 2019. Repair methodologies for both canal seawalls were reviewed and geotechnical testing to mitigate unknown factors to be performed.GMP estimates (July/August) were high and the upsized watermain has been removed from the scope as a value engineering measure to meet the project budget. Updated drawings were submitted and the pre-application meeting took place on October 6 (after a 2-month delay). Plans submitted to Building Services on November 4. The review comments received and Consultant revised and resubmitted the plans mid-December. Permitting with outside agencies (Broward County) being finalized. Coordination with Lauderdale By The Sea residents and staff is ongoing. Alternative decorative media for the bridge barrier walls are being reviewed . Discussion with original artist ongoing. Permitting is completed. Outreach completed and project signs installed. Work began in 3rd week of February 2021 and construction progress has been steady. NPDES protection in place, Selective demolition of Pile Caps 1 and 2 completed and dowelled installed in March. Concrete placing scheduled for mid April. Coordination with art work and lighting submittal ongoing. Impact bridge traffic negligible to none. Work in place 20%.











## PROJECT FORECAST

Selective demolition is expected to continue for pile cap #3 as well as initial seawall construction . Coordination for artwork and lighting procurement will continue over the next 30 days.
